- Be able to show empathy when you have to give bad news. You should be able to tell the pet's owner.



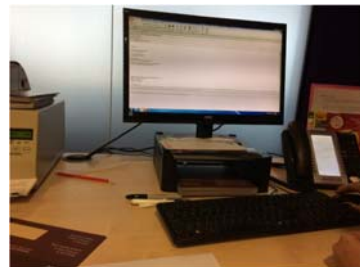
...a Vet

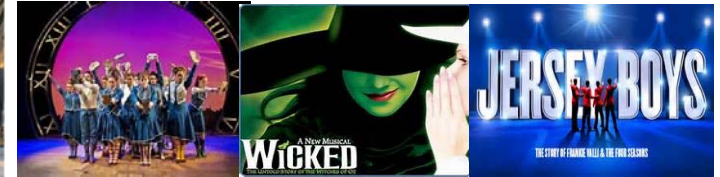
