
Mother and Daughter Rounders Tournament

THE RANGE ROVER EVOQUE WISE SCHOLARSHIP - £9,000 BURSARY FOR FEMALE ENGINEERING STUDENTS



Jaguar, Land Rover and WISE are offering sponsorship to three female scholars wishing to pursue engineering at University or as an apprentice – you will also act as an Ambassador for Jaguar Land Rover and be able to take part in a summer work placement. According to a report published by Engineering UK, Britain needs to double the number of engineering graduates and triple the number of engineering apprentices by 2020 to meet industry needs. At present, just thirteen per cent of engineering undergraduates are female, a problem Land Rover is determined to address. In addition to the Range Rover Evoque WISE Scholarship, Land Rover already runs specific training schemes to support ambitious female engineers.

Who is eligible to apply for this scholarship?



Young women who have completed their GCSEs or A Levels and wish to study an engineering degree or apprenticeship. The following degree choices are acceptable: Mechanical, Electrical, Automotive, Electronic, Systems Integration, Aeronautical, and Aerospace. If you are following an apprenticeship route then you need to be doing at least a 3 year apprenticeship in an Engineering discipline. Applicants must be accepted into a university or college of your choice and intending to pursue an engineering career.

Why is this scholarship only open to female students?

Jaguar Land Rover wants to encourage more females to consider engineering careers to increase its talent pool. Jaguar Land Rover needs more engineers, both female and male, to help our technology and engineering-led business achieve ambitious plans for global growth. Promoting women in engineering makes good business sense, because a workforce composed of people from diverse backgrounds and experiences better reflects the profile of our customers, helping us understand and respond to their needs.



What subjects are they specifically looking for from applicants?

Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Design and Technology, Computing, Engineering, Construction and Manufacturing are some of the possible subjects they are looking for.

The Range Rover Evoque WISE Scholarship will provide a £9,000 bursary to three female students or apprentices who would like to explore a career or further studies in engineering. In addition the winners will be provided with mentoring support from both Land Rover senior engineers and WISE representatives.
