Languages Week

On Monday, as part of Languages week, girls from the Junior School had a visit from Señor Morgan (Head of Languages). They learnt that many English words such as tomato or avocado came from the Aztec language. They also discovered where chocolate originated from and how the Spaniards brought it to Europe.

Madame Davies introduced the girls to the uTalk Junior Language Challenge 2019/20, the only language



competition for primary schools. The participants will develop their speaking and listening skills in Spanish for the 1st round and French for the 2nd round. The girls from Years 3 to 6 have been invited to enter the competition. At the end of Round 2 the highest scoring children for their region will be invited to take part in a Regional Final. This is an amazing opportunity for our pupils to excel at languages and get recognition for their success.
