Tips

- You achieve your award by meeting **all of the requirements for the award** satisfactorily. To do this, you must obtain a signature from the teacher involved in **each activity or event** to confirm your attendance.

- **Don't forget** to add any roles of responsibility you have, e.g. Form Prefect – every little counts!
- Use the **Teambuilding Experience** section to write about your experiences on the Year 7 bonding trip in September.
- Remember to ask for extra pages if you run out of space!
